My History

- First website (home page) around 1993.
- Redesigned in 2007 with the help of colleague Hykel Hosni.
- Started using Twitter in Sep 2009.
- Started Wordpress blog in Jan 2013.
- Have but do not use Facebook, LinkedIn accounts.

Definitions

Blog

- Blog = web log.
- Posts in reverse order.
- Usually creatable without using html.
- Content management system underneath.
- Free hosting from Wordpress, Blogger (Google), etc.

Twitter

Particular form of microblogging with 140 character limit.

Why Blog or Tweet?

- Instant publication.
- (Quick) feedback on ideas/requests.
- Announcements: jobs, tech reports, confs, software, ...
- Sharing interesting links.
- Promoting research: summary of talk or paper.
- Passing on tips about software etc.
- "Making stuff available".

Desiderata of Blog

- Have a theme.
- Have something to say.
- May or may not express opinions.
- Be unique.
- Provide useful information.
- Be controversial?
- Regular posts.
- Posts that are not papers!

Excellent advice on Wordpress site.

Feedback


- Stats/analytics show popularity of posts, search terms, etc.
- Blog: comments on post page.
- Twitter: replies, retweets.

My Blogging (2013–)

- The Nearest Correlation Matrix: written to collect different software implementations and promote use of the best method.
- Book reviews.
- Report on meetings: Cardiff SIAM Student Chapter, SIAM CSE13 ("your published algorithms are slowly making their way into scipy (the main scientific python library"),...
- LATEX, Beamer, PDF viewer tips.

My Blogging (2013–), cont.

- Historical info: Lanczos Tapes, Sir Horace Lamb, Arthur Buchheim ("I've just found your recent blog on Arthur Buchheim whilst researching my family tree and it seems he is probably a distant relative").
- 15 comments (+ 171 spam).

How to Blog

- (E.g.) Wordpress.com or Wordpress.org. Many themes available, customizable.
- To write a post
 - use wysywig interface,
 - write html,
 - post from Emacs org2blog.
- Organize: choose categories (not too many) and tags carefully.
- Promote posts via Twitter.
- Make RSS feed available.

Misc Wordpress

- Wordpress supports LATEX. Put LATEX in dollar signs. Even: \$\LaTeX\$.
- May 2013: Wordpress changed the font for listings. Had to edit an old post.
- Wordpress.com shows adverts to people not logged in to Wordpress. Can pay \$30 per year for no ads.
- Comments are automatically accepted from a person once one has been accepted.

Discovery

- Google indexes blogs.
- Can subscribe to a blog via RSS feed, or within Wordpress.
- I tend to reach via Twitter: post announcements or recommendations from other readers.
- Hootsuite Social Media Management Dashboard has an RSS Reader app.

Twitter Tips

- Lists invaluable for scanning feeds by topic. E.g., people, software, news.
- New followers often come after tweets and retweets.
- Hashtags useful for collecting Tweets about an event: #SIAMAN13, #SIAMCSE13.
- Conference prize for best Tweet (see Manchester Student Chapter 2013 meeting).
- "Tip" feeds can be a good way to learn a topic.



Data Preservation

- Principle of data in-data out. Keep backup of your tweets and blog posts.
 - Twitter allows download of archive of tweets.
 - Wordpress allows export of content.
- Shortened URLs are not guaranteed to be preserved.
